## Like

Preposição: **como, igual a.**

I want to be **like** him.

John loves spicy food, **like** me.

My uncle treats me **like** a daughter.



## Like

Verbo: **gostar.**

Do you **like** English?

I **like** James but I don't **like** his sister much.

Tom **likes** to play soccer on Saturdays.



## Look like

**se parecer com alguém.**

What does Mia **look like**?

She **looks** just **like** her mother.

Your hair **looks like** mine.



# It looks like ...

**Parece que.**

It looks like it's snowing in there.

It looks like the restaurant is still open.

It looks like a balloon.



# Be like ...

am/is/are

**ser, parecer  
(aparência, personalidade ou descrição).**

What's she like?

She's friendly and generous.

What's the weather like today?

It's sunny and hot.
