

# THERE IS - ARE



We use **there is/there are** to say that something exists.

We use **there isn't/there aren't** to say that something doesn't exist.

We use **there is/there isn't** + singular noun.



**Is there** a pink car in the driveway?  
Yes, **there is**.

**Is there** a snowman in front of the house?  
No, **there isn't**.

We use **there are/there aren't** + plural noun.



**Are there** people in front of the house?  
Yes, **there are**.

**Are there** pets with them?  
No, **there aren't**.
